OSHA COMPLIANCE & INJURY PREVENTION

The purpose of this 2016 OSHA and Injury Prevention class is to help prepare organizations for complex regulatory compliance, injury prevention, and business liability. The course will review the new 2016 Silica Standard, Electrical Hazard Awareness, and Medical Record Access. Participants will learn about OSHA's revised Record Keeping & Injury Reporting standard that will impact manufacturers with twenty or more employees taking effect on January 1, 2017.
