## Manufacturing 101:

## Problem Solving and Critical Thinking:

Provides an understanding of why we think the way we do and various ways to become better problem solvers.



## Goal Setting:

Setting personal and professional goals to build a career versus showing up for a paycheck. Helping participants to find their 'why' and letting it be the driver to enjoy work and constantly improve skills.
